

CHEVRON STUDIO WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

Last modified: January 1, 2026

INTRODUCTION

Chevron Mediterranean Limited (the "**Company**" or "**we**" or "**us**") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal information that we collect and hold about you. The Privacy Policy below describes how we collect information, the types of information collected, how the information is used, and your data subject's rights.

As part of your use of and browsing on the Chevron Studio Website (the "**Website**"), including submitting an application to participate in the Chevron Studio program in Israel operated by the Company (the "**Program**") or contacting us through the "Contact" section of the Website, we may collect, store, and process information about you as described in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to the terms of the Privacy Policy, you are not authorized to access and/or use the websites and/or the information, content, products, or services offered therein.

Terms that are not defined in this Privacy Policy will have the meanings attributed to them in the Protection of Privacy Law, 1981 (the "**Protection of Privacy Law**").

The data controller of the database and the personal information that will be The Company. Contact details of the Company are provided in the section "INFORMATION ABOUT US".

WHAT DATA WE ARE COLLECTING?

When you use the Company's Website, we may collect and process the following types of data about you or about third parties, as listed below.

Personal Information Collected Directly from You

We will collect personal information that you provide to us as part of contacting the Company, submitting an application to participate in the Program, or using the "Contact" section of the Website. This may include, without limitation, your full name, company name, job title, address, phone number, email address, LinkedIn profile URL, and any other identifying information you choose to share with the Company.

You are not required by law to provide the Company with your personal information, and the provision of personal information is made at your own free will and consent. However, you agree that without providing the requested information, the Company may not be able to process your application or respond to your inquiries.

Without prejudice to the foregoing, if you provide personal information about any third parties (such as your team members), you represent and warrant that you have obtained all necessary consents, approvals, and authorizations from those individuals to share their details and personal information with the Company and/or anyone acting on its behalf and/or the Company's business partners and other relevant third parties (as appropriate). You will be solely responsible in this regard.

Information We May Derive About You

When you use the Website, the data and information we collect about you (for example, actions you have taken, instructions you have given, pages you have viewed, offers and services that interested you, etc.) may be processed, both manually and through computerized and automated tools, to generate insights that will allow us to improve services, tailor them to your activities, and more.

When you use the Website, you automatically provide us with your IP address or other identifiers depending on the network or device you are using. This information is collected by us to improve your user experience, determine your geographic location, and for security purposes.

HOW WE USE THE DATA

We will use the collected data and personal information about you for legitimate business purposes, including:

- To process and review your application to participate in the Program, including evaluating your eligibility and suitability;
- To contact you in follow-up to your application or inquiry submitted through the Website, or when we believe that there is a need to fulfill another requirement under applicable law;
- To provide support and handle requests or complaints related to the Website or the Program;
- In order to comply with any law, regulation, or other legal obligation and to assist authorized authorities and any third party, when we reasonably believe that we should do so;
- Without prejudice to the foregoing, we may use non-identifiable information for various legitimate purposes, such as improving services and applications, adapting content, and conducting statistical research.

TRANSFER OF INFORMATION TO THIRD PARTIES

We may transfer your personal information and other data collected about you to third parties, including vendors, service providers, and business partners, in the following cases:

- As necessary to process your application to the Program, include engaging external advisors assisting us in evaluating applications, our partners in the Program and service providers related to the Program, and to enable the proper operation of the Website;
- Such third parties participating in the committee evaluating the applications to the Program.
- To affiliated companies within the group managing the Program jointly, for the purpose of operating and administering the Program;
- As required for the operation of the Website, including the transfer of information to data hosting companies, IT consultants and other operational vendors;
- If we are required to do so by a court order, a request from an authorized authority, or by law;
- If we receive a notice of legal action against us due to actions taken by you and also in any dispute, claim, lawsuit, demand, or legal proceedings, if any, between you and the Company and/or its affiliates and/or someone on its behalf;
- As part of the organizational and operational structure of the Company (including in the event that the Company reorganizes its activities within the framework of another entity – including a merger with another entity), then we will be entitled to transfer to the other entity the personal information or any other information that has accumulated about you;
- If an allegation is raised or a suspicion arises that you have committed an act or omission that harms or may harm the Company and/or someone on its behalf and/or any third parties;
- Upon your express request.
- If we reasonably believe that you may be suitable for another initiative or program operated by us or an affiliated company, including ventures related to the Company, we may share your information for that purpose.

You agree that the Company will be entitled, at its discretion, to transfer the personal information outside the borders of Israel, even if the law of the country to which the personal information is transferred and/or stored guarantees a different level of protection than the level of protection for information set forth in Israeli law.

DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

According to the Protection of Privacy Law, every person is entitled to inspect, in person or by a representative authorized in writing or by a guardian, the information about them held in a database. A person who has inspected the information about them and found that it is not accurate, complete, clear, or up-to-date is entitled to request the database controller to correct or delete the information. If the controller refuses, they must notify the requester of this in the manner and manner prescribed in the regulations.

Privacy Policy Changes

The Company may change the terms of this Privacy Policy from time to time. If the Policy is changed in a significant way, a notice will be posted on the home page of the applicable website(s) 7 days before the changes take effect, unless the changes originates from any legal or regulatory requirement, in which case, the change shall enter into force in accordance with such requirement.

Your continued use of the website and the services offered on it after such a change will constitute evidence of your acknowledgment and acceptance of the changes. It is recommended to review the provisions of the Privacy Policy each time you revisit the website to stay informed of any changes (if any) made to the Privacy Policy.
